



## **Adjunct Faculty**

Notre Dame College operates on semesters. We use adjunct instructors when our full-time faculty aren't available to teach courses. Our needs vary based on enrollment and scheduling. We accept resumes year round but department chairs may not contact applicants immediately. The majority of our hiring is done in the summer for fall classes. It is helpful to review our course catalog to understand what academic programs we offer and types of courses.

- Successful candidates will have a graduate degree or a minimum of 18 graduate credit hours in the area in which they will be teaching.
- Online teaching experience is preferred.

**Philosophy:** The desirable candidate for philosophy will have experience teaching courses in ethics, critical thinking and/or introduction to western philosophy.

**Theology:** The ideal candidate has an MA or a Ph.D. in Theology or a D.Min. and possesses a solid academic background in Roman Catholic, Vatican II-centered theology
